## CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, FRESNO SERVICE IMPACT ON THE COMMUNITY 2016-2017 ACADEMIC YEAR REPORT

The following table details the contributions provided to the Central Valley and beyond through California State University Fresno's community service and service-learning efforts. All figures were provided by direct sources, such as program coordinators. They were collected and tallied by the Jan & Bud Richter Center for Community Engagement and Service-Learning.

The *Independent Sector's* most recent estimates (2016) place the value of an hour of volunteer time in California at \$28.46 (http://www.independentsector.org/volunteer\_time). This figure was multiplied by the **1,386,449 of service hours** Fresno State students provided in 2016-17. The economic impact of that service is, therefore, estimated to be in excess of \$39.4 million. When combined with the financial support students gained by involvement in these programs, **the total economic impact of the university's community service-learning efforts is estimated at nearly \$40.2 million for the 2016-17 academic year.**

iii There are 6 Fresno State Blood Drives each year. A large number of students, staff and faculty are regular donors who participate in each drive. It is not practical to identify the number of unique donors,

therefore, no specific number of Fresno State community members involved is provided for this initiative. While donation time varies, a general average for the entire donation process is one hour.

iv The Work Study funds indicated were used specifically for community service placements in community benefit organizations. The figure does not include the Work Study Funds earned by Jumpstart Fresno or Reading and Beyond at Fresno State students. Those totals are reported separately under the appropriate program.

v Total number of students likely includes some double counting of students who were involved in two or more service programs. It is not possible to provide an accurate, unduplicated count of students involved in all service initiatives.

vi As much as possible, the number of total hours is an accurate figure that does **not** reflect doublecounting between programs.
